- 2010 NBTA rules will be in effect.
- Order of performance and lane assignments will be listed in regional program. Pageant contestants: will perform in alphabetical order starting with the letter "D". All modeling events: will start with the letter "D". Group events, Show Twirl and Rhythmic Twirl: will be listed. Sunday Individual Events: the first entries received will be the last to perform. The last entries received will be the first to perform. The order of appearance will be listed in the program.
- Contest floor reserved for contestants and contest officials only. No practicing will be permitted on Friday night.
- Contestants must wear tennis shoes or soft sole dance shoes on gym floor.
- Food and drinks will be available. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on premises. No smoking allowed.
- ADMISSION: In order to eliminate long lines to enter the facility, there is a door/facility surcharge of \$37.50 attached to each solo entry. If there is more than one child per family, only one surcharge will be charged, but must be sent together. This surcharge eliminates daily admission.
