## SPECIAL EVENTS

- “First Trophy” Best Appearing for competitors who have never won first place in best appearing.

MISS MAJORETTE OF THE WOODLANDS: Judged 2/5 twirling, 2/5 strutting, 1/5 modeling, Modeling Attire: Novice, Beginner and Intermediate – costume; Advance - dress. Twirling status determines level of competition. Modeling performed in circle “T” pattern.

MISS COLLEGE MAJORETTE OF THE WOODLANDS: Judged 2/5 twirling, 2/5 strutting, 1/5 modeling, MUST BE ATTENDING COLLEGE.

MISS WOODLANDS MODELING PAGEANT: Judged on ½ modeling, ½ interview. Modeling attire: Sportswear, Party Dress, Formal or Costume. Modeling performed in circle T pattern.

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT: Novice twirlers only. Judged on 40% basic strut, 40% twirling, 20% modeling in costume. No interview. Modeling performed in a circle “T” pattern.

## CONTEST EVENTS

BEST COSTUME: Overall appearance of contestant with emphasis on fit and designs of costume. No Baton.

BEST APPEARING IN COSTUME: Model in circle “T” pattern in costume. No Baton. 1 minute maximum.

BEST APPEARING IN DRESS: Model in circle “T” pattern in party dress or formal. 1 minute maximum.

PRESENTATION: Performance is judged on poise, personality, baton technique, poses, and movement technique.

FANCY STRUT: 1-1/2 to 2 minutes. Follow “X” pattern.

NOVICE FANCY STRUT: No minimum time. Follow “X” pattern.

BASIC STRUT: Marching in left square. No twirling.

PARADE MAJORETTE/TWIRL STRUT: Marching with twirling. Floor pattern optional. Judged on variety, difficulty, and execution of baton twirling with body work while staying in step.

MILITARY MARCH: Marching in left square with military bearing including a military beating of time.

NOVICE SOLO: No minimum time to 2 minutes. Contestant has won fewer than 3 first places.

BEGINNER SOLO: 1-1/2 to 2 minutes. Contestant has won fewer than 5 Beginner first place trophy.

INTERMEDIATE SOLO: 1:50 – 2:10 minutes. Contestant has won fewer than 8 Intermediate first place trophy.

ADVANCE SOLO: 2:20 – 2:30 minutes. Contestant has won the required number of firsts in all pervious divisions.

TWO BATON: 1-1/2 – 2 minutes

THREE BATON: 1:00 – 2 minutes

SHOW TWIRL: 1-1/2 – 2-1/2 minutes- provide your own music - 1, 2, 3 Baton or other props.

RHYTHMIC TWIRL: 1:30-2:30 - provide your own music – 1 baton only

UIL / TRYOUT ROUTINE 1:30 – 3:00 - provide your own music

Divisions: Determined by average age as of 09-01-09 – Tiny Tot 0-7, Juvenile 8-10.9, Junior 11-13.9, Senior 14 –25

DUETS: 2:20 to 2:30 minutes. Classification: Twirling. Divisions determined by combined ages.
